A Transitional Review is a meeting with people who can help you plan your future.

People who may come to the meeting:

- » You
- » Your parents
- » Your teacher
- » Your Personal Adviser
- » The Local Education Authority Assessment Officer



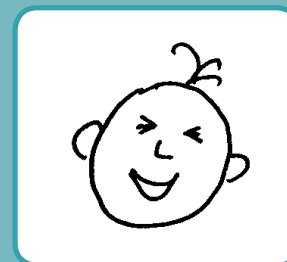
Other people who can help you:

- » Where you will live
- » What makes you happy
